



Oaxaca Education Fund 5K Walk

Your contributions to the **Oaxaca Education Fund** will benefit the children of migrant workers from Oaxaca, Mexico. Their fathers worked in the fields between Rancho Peñasquitos and Del Mar in San Diego. There is very little paid work in the mountains of Oaxaca, and parents must pay for uniforms, school supplies, and high school fees. Oaxaca Education Fund/Friends of the Poor provides school supplies to all the children in grades K-12 in five villages in Oaxaca. We purchase the supplies in Mexico and distribute them to **1500 students** with the help of local youth. We also enable **125 young people to stay in high school** by assisting with their fees, we help **17 college** students with expenses *and* we help support **33 children who are orphaned or disabled**. These are the families of the men who for decades grew our vegetables in Carmel Valley. Thank you for helping their children stay in school in Mexico and look forward to a better future!
